### TERMS OF REFERENCE

- (b) Applicant shall be a resident of the area encompassed by Wellington Masonic District (Guelph, Acton, Georgetown, Erin, Fergus, Elora and Drayton).
- (c) Financial need will be deemed of major importance.
- (d) Applicants may be required to furnish proof of acceptance into their proposed course of study.

### METHOD OF APPLICATION

Application shall be by letter outlining scholastic achievements, interests, activities and proposed course of study. The application should be supported by two letter of reference.

Applications should be received by the Secretary of the Wellington District Past Masters', Masters' and Wardens' Association not later than ~~June 30th~~ <sup>May 7</sup>. Recipients shall be notified by August 15th and the presentation will be made in October.
