Registration Procedures

Revised June 2016

(Excluding admissions from Grade 8)

AGE

- Students under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, adult with legal custody or social agency (i.e. CAS/HASS/etc).
- Students 18 years of age and over do not require a parent, etc. but must provide proof of residency in our school attendance area (license/lease/cancelled rent cheque/etc.) ***If these students have residency outside of Halton, please see the principal for direction.***
- Students 16 or 17 years of age that are living on their own must provide proof of residency. When unsure, please contact a member of administration.
- All persons who wish to register as landed immigrants, student visas, etc. ***are to be referred to the principal.***

F. REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

All new registrants must provide the following documentation unless they are transferring from another Halton District School Board school:

- Birth certificate or passport
- O.E.N. (Ontario Education Number)
- Immunization record (letter from doctor or immunization card)
- Proof of residency (proof of home purchase/driver's license/etc.)
- Most recent report card
- Ontario Student Transcript if applicable

G. STUDENTS FROM ANOTHER HIGH SCHOOL WITHIN HALTON (PUBLIC OR SEPARATE)

If the student wishing to register is or has attended another high school in Halton (public or private), he or she is to be given the "Student Application for Admission" and bring the completed form to the appointment that has been scheduled with the principal or vice principal (see attached). Appointments with the principal or vice-principal may be made through our main office.

Upon completion of the intake interview, the administrator involved will schedule an appointment for registration with the appropriate counselor.

FORMER GEORGETOWN DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WISHING TO RE-REGISTER ARE TO BE SENT DIRECTLY TO THE OFFICE IN ORDER TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE APPROPRIATE ADMINISTRATOR.

INTAKE PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS OUTSIDE GDHS BOUNDARIES OR CURRENTLY ATTENDING A PRIVATE OR SEPARATE SCHOOL IN GRADE 8

SITUATION ONE

"My child currently attends Grade 8 in a public elementary school in the Halton District School Board but Georgetown District High School is not the "home" high school in the area in which I live."

- You must apply for "optional attendance" by contacting your son's or daughter's home high school principal and requesting a form for "optional attendance from Grade 8 to Grade 9".
- This form must be completed and returned to the principal of the home high school by the due date indicated on the form.
- The decision for optional attendance should be completed by the end of February. The principal of the receiving high school will inform you of the decision.
- If you are granted optional attendance to Georgetown District High School, you will be contacted by the school and sent a course selection sheet for Grade 9.
- Optional attendance is granted on a year by year basis.
- Students exercising optional attendance are not eligible for bus transportation provided by the Halton District School Board

"This process does not apply to Grade 8 students and parents who are considering entry into the Essentials Program at GDHS. Contact for entry into this program can be initiated through contacting your current school or by calling Mr. Riley Watson or Ms. Sarah Lamont, Learning Services at Georgetown District High School (905-877-6966 Ext. 245)."

SITUATION TWO

"My child currently attends Grade 8 in the Halton Roman Catholic District School Board OR attends Grade 8 in a private school."

Your son or daughter would be considered a "new" registration to the Halton District School Board and as such the following information would have to be provided:

- Proof of residency in the Georgetown District High School area (check the Halton District School Board website www.haltondsb.on.ca and use the "School Locator").
- Birth or baptismal certificate or passport or other proof of Canadian citizenship
- Proof of immunization (check with your family doctor)
- Copy of your son's or daughter's most recent Grade 8 report card

In addition, our Learning Services Department would contact your current school in order to determine whether your son or daughter is formally identified as a special needs student or is currently receiving any additional learning support.

This process of registration for Grade 9 can be initiated by contacting Ms. Nancy Cannell, Guidance Assistant at 905-877-6966 Extension 219. When we are contacted we will set up an appointment for you to meet with a counselor to register as well as complete a course selection sheet for Grade 9.

At this point in time, we cannot register any students from a separate or private school who do not live in the Georgetown District High School attendance area.
